


## **SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY**

Key Transportation has developed these health/safety transportation protocols following CDC guidelines. These standards have been developed to protect the health of both passengers and drivers. As our community begins to open up, we believe sharing these guidelines with guests, hotels and industry groups will illustrate the precautions our industry is taking to ensure the safety of our community.

- All drivers should wear masks. These need to be washed each night before use again the next day or the driver must have more than one.
- ♦ All vehicles should have disinfectant wipes with 70% alcohol or EPA certified known products that kill the virus with disposable cleaning supplies available.
- All drivers should wipe down door handles, seat backs, window controls, hard surfaces and seat belts after each passenger with one of the wipes and ideally wearing gloves. At the end of each shift, these materials would need to be cleaned first (with soap & water) and then disinfected again.
- ♦ Chauffeurs have been advised to limit all physical contact or materials sharing between chauffeurs and clients where possible
- ♦ Water is kept in a cooler with the chauffeur and offered to guests using a paper towel. Water cartons are immediately removed using a paper towel or gloves after the ride is completed
- ♦ All printed and reading materials have been removed from seat-back pockets
- Hand sanitizer (65-95% alcohol) is placed in each vehicle
- Social Distancing will be adhered to in vehicle capacities, with passengers wearing facial covering:
  - Sedans/SUV's: 1 person unless traveling with partner or members of household
  - **Sprinter/ Vans:** Twenty five- Thirty percent (25-30%) capacity, 1 person per row, unless traveling with partners/members of same household grouping
  - Minibuses/Motorcoaches: Twenty five- Fifty percent (25-50%) capacity, 1 person every other row, unless traveling with partners/members of same household grouping \*Please see diagram below\*
